Amid the current health concerns regarding the COVID-19 global outbreak, we at the Asian Pacific Community Fund are continuously monitoring the situation. As more statements are released by the government, APCF is taking the following measures to ensure that the health and safety of our staff and the community that we serve remain top priority:

TAKING CARE OF OUR TEAM

While the APCF office located within Asian Americans Advancing Justice – Los Angeles remains open and operational as of today, both offices IMMEDIATELY will not be taking any in-person meetings and the community space is closed to prevent as much personal contact as possible. We have also implemented new policies within our organization to stop COVID-19 from spreading. APCF has offered telecommuting options to its staff to alleviate any strain caused by the closure of various school districts and programs.

TAKING CARE OF OUR COMMUNITY AND THE NON-PROFITS WHO SERVE IT

While our [56 Nonprofit Network Agencies in Los Angeles and Orange Counties](#) continue to provide essential services to their constituents daily, APCF is committed to supporting our nonprofit partners by sharing available resources from local, state, and federal governments and by connecting them to potential funding and in-kind resources available from corporations and foundations. APCF will soon distribute our [2020 Unrestricted Operating Grants](#) to our API-serving nonprofits, which will allow grantees to use these funds to address their current program needs caused by the coronavirus outbreak in our local API communities.

UPCOMING PROGRAMMING

APCF [Capacity Building Workshops](#) to train volunteers, staff, and board members of API-serving nonprofits are currently on hiatus as we work to transition to virtual workshops in the near future. The [2020 Board Leadership Program](#) is still being evaluated, so please keep an eye out for updates on those sessions. Currently, the deadline of [six low-income scholarships for high school seniors and college students](#) remains as March 25, but updates will be provided should anything change. We will determine the status of all our upcoming programming in accordance with our building and the latest updates from public health agencies.
